Books - if possible, please cite individual chapters, not entire books

Last name first name initials with a dot with a space (comma space) at the end (dot space) **Chapter title (Bold font)** (dot space) In (colon space) Book editors name first name initials with a dot with a space (comma space) at the end (dot space)) (Editor / Editors) **Book title (Bold font)** (dot space) year (semicolon space) Publisher (space) (City / Country of publication if possible in parentheses) (semicolon space) ISBN (colon space) number (period)
